All visitors' ages 16 or less that is not seeking care themselves will not be permitted within the facility or clinics. Visitation hours have been changed to 7 am to 8 pm please enter through the main entrance and submit to the COVID-19 screening process. If you have an appointment please plan ahead and ensure you have childcare available. We apologize for the inconvenience and assure you we do not make the decisions without much deliberation. Safety and well being remains the top priority at Limestone Medical Center.

We at LMC would like to remind everyone take everyday precautions as we gear up to face the COVID-19 health threat.

Take everyday preventive actions:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Clean your hands often
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing, or having been in a public place.
- If soap and water are not available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- To the extent possible, avoid touching high-touch surfaces in public places – elevator buttons, door handles, handrails, handshaking with people, etc. Use a tissue or your sleeve to cover your hand or finger if you must touch something.
- Wash your hands after touching surfaces in public places.
- Avoid touching your face, nose, eyes, etc.
- Clean and disinfect your home to remove germs: practice routine cleaning of frequently touched surfaces (for example: tables, doorknobs, light switches, handles, desks, toilets, faucets, sinks & cell phones)
- Avoid crowds, especially in poorly ventilated spaces. Your risk of exposure to respiratory viruses like COVID-19 may increase in crowded, closed-in settings with little air circulation if there are people in the crowd who are sick.
- Avoid all non-essential travel including plane trips, and especially avoid embarking on cruise ships
